**Indoor meetings** are held at the High Street Methodist Church Hall, King Street, Maidenhead, SL6 1EA, starting at 7.30pm, ending around 9.30pm. Admission (which includes refreshments) is £4.00 for Local Group members and £5.00 for non-members.

**Outdoor events** can involve a good deal of walking. Bring suitable footwear and warm, waterproof clothing. Outdoor events may be cancelled at short notice if weather conditions are extreme. Cancellations will be posted on the home page of our website. If cancellation is likely, then ring Brian Reeve (01628 680810 walks) or Helen Pearson (01628 639648 coach trips) the previous day.

**Coach Trips** are all day events and involve a journey of two to three hours each way. Full payment is required on booking. For under 16's the cost is reduced by £10. All money will be refunded if the trip is cancelled. Book via Helen Pearson on 01628 639648, at least one week in advance, preferably weeks earlier. **The coach leaves promptly at 7.00 am** from the lay-by in front of the entrance to Braywick Park (Braywick Sports Ground), Braywick Road, Maidenhead, SL6 1DX. There is a free car park inside the park. Please arrive in good time. You may need to bring a packed lunch and any drinks or snacks that you require. During your coach trip, comfort stops will be made, facilities permitting. Generally, our coach trip venues have toilets (check details on our website). The coach has room for large items, eg telescopes, tripods, camera bags and purchases.

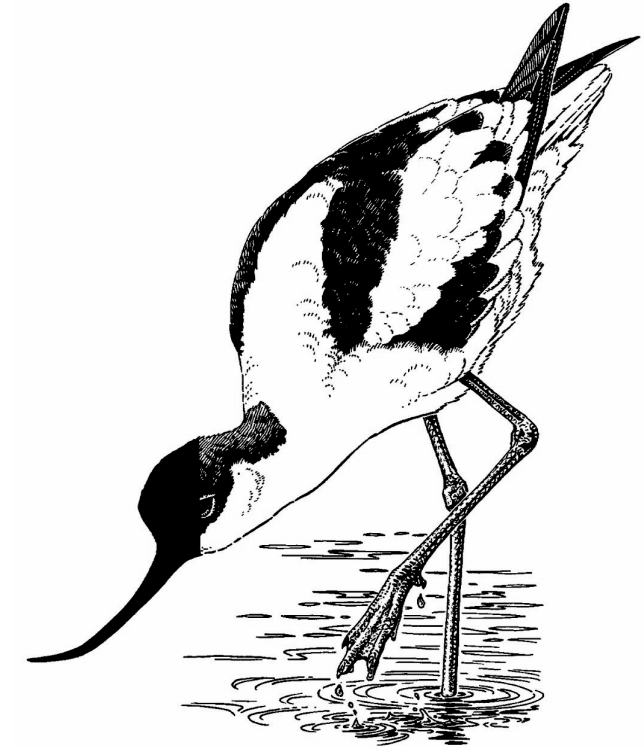
