

Come and join us

Talks and trips are open to everyone, especially those new to bird watching. You do not have to be a Group member to attend. **Beginners are especially welcome.** Our events are a great way to meet friendly, like-minded people in our area while learning more about birds and wildlife.

Indoor meetings are held at the High Street Methodist Church Hall, King Street, Maidenhead SL6 1EA, starting at 7.30pm, ending around 9.30pm. Admission (which includes refreshments) is £4.00 for Local Group members and £5.00 for non-members.


Outdoor events can involve a good deal of walking. Bring suitable footwear and warm, waterproof clothing. There is no charge but a small donation to the RSPB is appreciated. You may have to pay for parking or admission at a few locations. Outdoor events may be cancelled at short notice if weather conditions are extreme. Cancellations will be posted on our website and / or our Facebook page, so please check both.

Coach trips are all day events and involve a journey of two to three hours each way. Full payment of £25 is required on booking. For under 16s the cost is reduced by £10. All money will be refunded if the trip is cancelled. Book via Helen Pearson; email helen.ebrspb@gmail.com at least one week in advance, preferably earlier. **The coach leaves promptly at 7.00am** from the lay-by in front of the entrance to Braywick Park (Braywick Sports Ground), Braywick Road, Maidenhead SL6 1DX. There is a free car park inside the park. Please arrive in good time. You may need to bring a packed lunch and any drinks that you require. During your coach trip, comfort stops will be made, facilities permitting. Generally, our coach trip venues have toilets (check details on our website). The coach has room for large items, eg telescopes, tripods, camera bags and purchases.

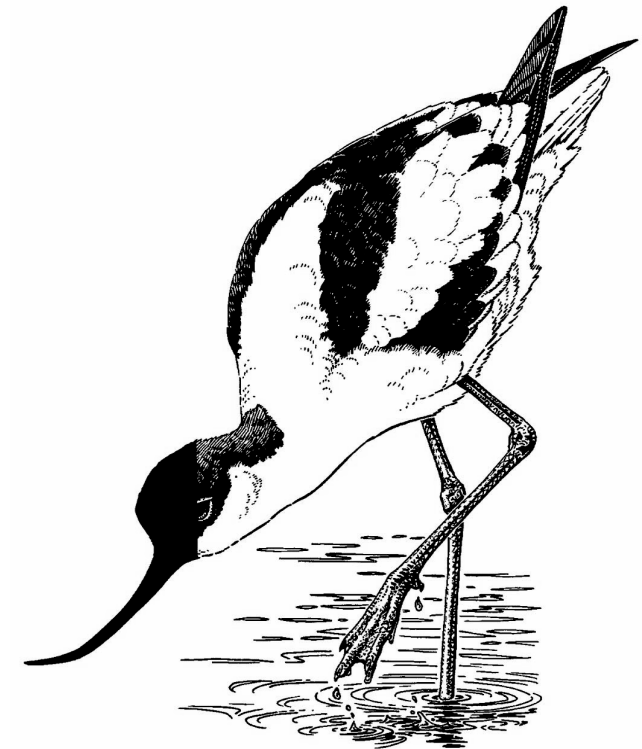
