

What's in it for you?

Servicing our boxes is an easy way to raise valuable funds for the RSPB and it is also rewarding for you as a volunteer.

The post is **flexible**, working around you. It is an enjoyable role that will get you out and about in your local area (a great excuse to try those yummy cakes in that cafe you have always wanted to try!)

The skills you need

The boxes will need to be serviced **every 4-6 weeks**, at your convenience. The money will need to be counted and then banked at any Post Office or PayPoint location, and then reported using our online system – ROBINS.

You will need to have a friendly and personable approach, a high level of motivation, good communication skills and the ability to work on your own. In addition, knowledge of shops, businesses, pubs and tourist attractions in your local area will be helpful.
